Comes the Garnishee and states that on January 13, 1923, Sam Turner whose address is Harrodsburg, Kentucky, delivered to it 1850 pounds of tobacco of the 1922 crop.

On said date Garnishee advanced to said Sam Turner on said delivery of tobacco the sum of \$222.83.

On January 20, 1923, said Sam Turner assigned to State Bank & Trust Co. his interest in the proceeds from the sale of said tobacco, in the sum of \$175.00 with interest at 6 per cent from January 13, 1923.

On March 10, 1923, said Sam Turner assigned to W. D. Sparrow, Burgin, Kentucky the balance of his interest in the proceeds from the sale of said tobacco.

Comes the Garnishee and states that on February 28, 1923, Sam Turner, whose address is Harrodsburg, Kentucky, delivered to it 3945 pounds of tobacco of the 1922 crop.

On said date Garnishee advanced to said Sam Turner on said delivery of tobacco, the sum of \$351.23.

On March 10, 1923, said Sam Turner assigned to State Bank & Trust Co., Harrodsburg, Kentucky, his interest in the proceeds from the sale of said tobacco, in the sum of \$309.00 with 6 per cent interest from March 2, 1923.

On March 10, 1923, said Sam Turner assigned to W. D. Sparrow, Burgin, Kentucky the balance of his interest in the proceeds from the sale of said tobacco.

Any further payments or sums due will depend upon future sales and amounts realized.
