The plaintiff, R.L.Black, states that on the 27th day of September 1921, the defendant executed and delivered to him for value received his certain promissory note for \$139.45, with interest thereon at the rate of 6% from date until paid and due and payable on January 1st, 1922. He says no part of said note has been paid though long past due and payment has been repeatedly demanded.

He says that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy the plaintiff's demand and the demands of the defendant's creditors and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found; that the defendant is in failing circumstances and probably insolvent.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$139.45 and interest thereon from the 27th day of September, 1921, and for all the costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant. He prays for all relief. Note will be filed on request.
