The Plaintiffs state that they are a partnership under the name and style of A. Sanders & Co; that the defendant H. H. Graham and Harrison Searcey were partners trading as Graham and Searcey in the year 1915; that said partnership acting through and by H. H. Graham on Oct 11, 1915 executed and delivered to the plaintiffs their written promissory note of that date by which they obligated and bound themselves six months thereafter to pay the sum of \$64.93 with 7% interest from its date until paid; that said note is long past due, no part has been paid except \$4.50 Oct. 11, 1915 and is filed as a part hereof.

They state that this is an action for the recovery of money due on said note and contract; that said claim is just, due and owing; that they believe they should recover said sum, interest and costs; that the defendant has no property subject to execution, ~~and~~ not enough thereof to satisfy this claim, interest and costs, and the collection thereof will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found; that Harrison Searcey is a non-resident of Kentucky; that he has no property of any kind or character in said State and has no property therein subject to execution.

Wherefore they pray judgment for \$60.43 with 6% interest thereon from Oct. 11, 1915 until paid and costs, and for a general order of attachment and for all proper relief.
