} PETITION

The plaintiff, L. H. Willis, states that the defendant, F. C. Chelf is indebted to him in the sum of One Hundred, Twelve Dollars and Fifty cents (\$112.50) for money had and received of the plaintiff by the said defendant on the _____ day of February, 1918. That the said sum is balance of an amount forwarded to the defendant by plaintiff, at said time, in payment for certain field or garden seeds, sold and to be delivered or shipped to plaintiff by the defendant; but that the said seeds to said amount were not shipped or delivered to plaintiff by the said defendant, or otherwise.

The plaintiff states that the said amount is just and due plaintiff and which the said defendant agreed and promised to repay, but that not part of the same has ever been paid, and that he ought to recover the said amount of \$112.50 with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum from February 1, 1918.
