Plaintiff says this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due, and unpaid, and that he ought to recover thereon said sum with interests and costs.

He says defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore, he prays for a judgment for \$32.00 with interest thereon the rate of 6% from January 1, 1918, until paid, ^{and the further sum of \$11.15} subject to a credit on interest of \$10.00. He asks for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant and for all relief.
