Plaintiff, Cleo Royalty says that under date of ~~January~~ ^{June} 24th 1926 the defendant by his certain promissory note duly executed and delivered parolised and agreed to pay this palintiff the sum of \$ 60.00 and interest from the date above setout. That said note was due and payable six months after--to-wit December 24th 1926. Plaintiff says that said money is now due and owing and that payment has been demanded but that the defendant has failed and refused and still fails and refuses to pay same and that the whole of same is now due and owing.

Wherefore & Etc.

For further cause of action against defendant plaintiff says that said defendant is indebted to him in the sum of \$ 28.95 for goods and merchandise which this plaintiff sold and delivered to this defendant at his special instance and request and ~~that~~ for which he promised and agreed to pay for. Plaintiff says that defendant has failed and refused and still fails and refuses to pay same altho often demanded of him and that the whole of same is now due and owing.

WHEREFORE* & Etc.

Plaintiff says that this is an action for money due up n a contract; that the defendant has no ~~money~~ property in this State subject to execution to execution or not enough* thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment or a return of no property found.
