

county of Mercer, but he has departed therefrom, with an attempt to defraud his creditors, and has left the county of Mercer to avoid the serving of a summons, or is concealing himself so that a summons cannot be served upon him.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays judgment against defendant for the sum of \$14.28, for cost of this action, and for general order of attachment against defendant, including the garnishee, L. E. Myers Construction Company, and prays further for all other relief to which she may appear to be entitled.
