The State Bank and Trust Co, states that it is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kentucky ~~incorporated~~ with powers to do a general banking business to sue and be sued &c.

Plaintiff states that on August 26th 1926, the defendant Charles Beckham, executed and delivered to it his promissory note, by which he promised to pay 6 months after date, the sum of \$ 200.00 with interest at the rate of 6% per-annum from date until paid. Plaintiff states that no part of said note has been paid, except \$ 113.49 which was paid May 10th 1927. That said note is now past due and owing. Wherefore &c.

Par. No. 2. Plaintiff further states that on Sept. 18th 1926, for value received the defendant executed and delivered to it his promissory note, by which he promised to pay to the plaintiff 4 months after date the sum of \$ 50.00 with interest from maturity until paid. Plaintiff states that no part of said note has been paid and that it is past due and owing.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant for the sum of \$ 200.00 subject to a credit of \$ 113.49 and interest from Feb'y. 26th 1927 until paid and for the sum of \$ 50.00 with interest from March 9th 1927 until paid and its cost herein expended.
