The plaintiff, Mrs. Mabel F. Dean, says that she is in the general store business and that her store is located at Ebenezer, in Mercer County Ky. She says that she sold & delivered to the defendant, goods, wares and merchandise to the value of \$77.59 balance, at his special instance and request, for which he agreed to pay the prices charged therefor; She says that the said sales were from November, 1, 1926 and August 1, 1928, She says that there were sales in a large amount and that various amounts were paid on the said account; a more detailed statement is filed herewith marked Exhibit "A".

Plaintiff states that the said claim is just, that she ought to recover thereon the sum of \$77.59 as she verily believes, that the defendant has no property in this State, subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy the claim of the plaintiff and defendant's other creditors, she says that her claim will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment ~~and~~ or return of no property found.

Wherefore she prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$77.59, for a general order of attachment, for her costs and for all other relief to which she may appear entitled.
