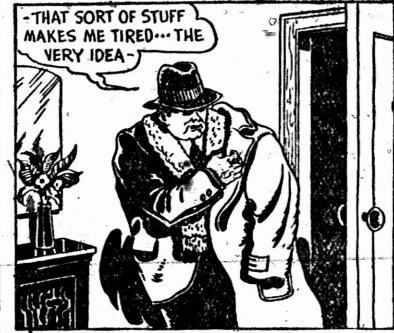

CLEAN MILK

Clean milk is milk that comes from healthy cows, is of good flavor and free from dirt, and contains only a small number of bacteria, none of which are harmful.

Great numbers of bacteria may get into the milk from the body of the cow and from utensils which have not been treated with heat (steam or boiling water) or a chlorine solution.

The number of bacteria may be kept at a minimum in milking by cleaning the cows, by using small top pails, and by thoroughly washing the utensils and then treating them with heat or a chlorine solution.

Disease-producing bacteria which get into milk are most likely to come from unhealthy cows, unhealthy persons who do the milking, contaminated water, flies, or filth.

Prompt cooling and storage at low temperatures retards the growth of bacteria in milk. Milk so handled keeps better and makes products of a higher quality.

Clean, well constructed stables, and separate milk rooms for handling the product, are important factors in the production of clean, wholesome, high quality milk and cream.

CHICKS WITH SHORT LEGS CAUSED BY DIET OF HENS

Newly hatched chicks with unusually short and shaky legs have been a puzzle to poultrymen.

Now poultry specialists of the United States Department of Agriculture have found that short-legged chicks often come from eggs laid by confined hens, which receive feed lacking satisfactory protein concentrates.

They found that not all meat meals furnish the proper kind of protein supplement for confined breeding stock. Several diets which contained meat meal as the sole protein supplement caused the hens to lay eggs from which short-legged chicks hatched. At the same time normal chicks hatched from eggs laid by hens receiving different kinds of meat meals as the only protein source.

Green grass, milk and some meat meals contain the factor necessary to prevent these short-legged chicks. Rations for confined breeding stock, the specialists advise, should include milk, alfalfa leaf meal, and cod liver oil.

MORE WHITES THAN NEGROES PREFER TO LIVE ON THE FARM

Miss Mary E. Frayser, home economist of the South Carolina agricultural experiment station, reports that in a survey of 1500 white and negro high school students, it has been found that more whites than negroes prefer the farm.

Out of 924 white and 576 negro high school students canvassed on the question: "Do you or do you not desire to live on a farm, 40 percent of the white and 23 percent of the negroes expressed a preference for the farm."

Outstanding among the reasons given for leaving the farm were low farm income, frequent lack of modern farm and home equipment, and the belief that cities offer more attractive economic, social and educational opportunities than the country.

Engineering led as the professional choice of the white boys and nursing of the white girls. Among the professions teaching was the first choice of both Negro boys and girls who planned to attend college. Farming was the first occupational choice of the white girls who had no expectation of going to college.

The data gathered from the white seniors in 1932 were supplanted by information secured in 1935. In the first mentioned year, 31.7 per cent of the sons of farmers named farming as their future occupation, but in 1935 it was found that 44.3 per cent were engaged in agriculture.

THOROUGHBRED HORSES ARE DESTROYED BY FIRE

Half a dozen thoroughbred horses, owned by W. C. Goodloe, were burned to death Sunday night when a fire destroyed a large barn which Mr. Goodloe had leased from the Lexington Water Company, approximately a mile from the Lexington city limits, just off the Richmond Pike. The loss was estimated at more than \$12,000.

Besides the horses, two automobiles, two trucks, a large quantity of hay and corn were destroyed in the blaze. The barn was valued at approximately \$6,000. Mr. Goodloe was in Miami, Florida, with a string of his racing horses.

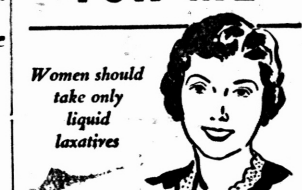
