

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

M E . Ward.

has committed the offense of uttering a check and delivering same on the Farmers Bank of Mackville, Ky, knowingly that he had no funds to pay same with, in the County of Mercer, the 12th day of March 1931

You are therefore commanded to arrest said M. E Ward,

and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
