The defendants having been duly summoned and failing to answer it is adjudged that the plaintiff J. T. Ingram recover of the defendants Etta B. McAtee and John G. McAtee, \$111.20 with 6% interest from December 1, 1923 until paid and the further sum of \$1.00 cost of filing mechanic's linn, together with his costs herein expended; it is further adjudged by the Court that the plaintiff has a lien to secure ~~said~~ the payment of said sums on one Cadillac car, Sedan Type, 59 Suburban, motor No. 59-Q-624; and that he is entitled to have said automobile sold to raise the amount of said debt. The defendants are ordered and adjudged to deliver said car into the possession of S. W. Kennedy, Sheriff of Mercer County, Kentucky, who is hereby appointed as Commissioner to enforce this judgment; a writ of possession will be issued for said car on demand of the Sheriff.

It is adjudged that said car shall be sold at public auction at a time and place to be fixed by the Sheriff and on a credit of three months. Before making said sale the Sheriff will cause the car to be advertised as is required by law in sales of similar property under execution; the plaintiff is adjudged to be entitled to an execution on this judgment.
