Plaintiff, Cogar Grain Coal & Feed Company, a corporation, doing business in the State of Kentucky, and with its principal place of business in Harrodsburg, Mercer County, Kentucky, states that defendant, Robert Robards is indebted to it in the sum of \$37.65, on account; that said account is just, due and unpaid, and though demand has been made upon defendant, he has failed and refused and still fails and refuses to pay said account, or any part of same. Wherefore etc.

Plaintiff states that this is an action upon a contract, being a contract to pay money on account; that said account is just; that it believes it ought to recover the amount of the account to wit, \$37.65; that defendant has no property in this state, subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy the demand of this plaintiff. and that the collection of the account will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays judgment against defendant for the sum of \$37.65, for the cost of this action, for a general order of attachment of property of defendant and for all other relief to which it may
