Plaintiff says that he is the sole owner of the assets of the late firm of Holman Hawkins & Company now dissolved; that as such there has come into his hands a certain note , dated July 1st., 1922, executed and delivered by the defendant, Effie Smith to Holman Hawkins & Company, said note being due and payable ~~three~~ months after date, in the amount of \$67.02 with interest from date until paid.

Plaintiff says that said note is subject to various credits and that there is now due on said note the sum of \$49.47 with interest from July 1st., 1925.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$49.47; for costs ~~of~~ this action and for all other relief to which he may appear to be entitled.
