Kentucky Central Life And Accident Insurance Company- Dft-

The plaintiff, Robert Cull states that on the 13th day of October 1924, he took out a policy of insurance in the defendant company by the terms of which he was to receive a weekly indemnity of \$8.00 per week during the time he was disabled by accident during the life of this policy. He says that on or about the 1st day of December 1926 and while the said policy was in full force and effect he sustained an injury by accident which totally disabled him from work for a period of 19 weeks and that the said defendant paid him the full indemnity of \$8.00 per week for a period of only 13 weeks leaving a balance due this plaintiff of 6 weeks indemnity or the sum of \$48.00. He says that the defendant is indebted to him in said sum of \$48.00 as aforesaid. Wherefore he prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$48. and all the costs of this action. Policy filed herewith-

PAR- 2- Plaintiff says that on the 22nd day of March 1926 he took out a policy with the said defendant, Kentucky Central Life and Accident Insurance Company, by the terms of which he was to receive a weekly indemnity of \$1.00 per week during the life of the policy. He says that on or about the 21st day of December 1926 and while said policy was in full force and effect he sustained an injury by accident which totally disabled him from work for a period of 19 weeks and that the said defendant paid him the full indemnity of \$1.00 per week for a period of 13 weeks leaving a balance due under said policy of \$6.00. He says that defendant is indebted to him in said sum of \$6.00 and all the costs of this policy filed-

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$48.00 as set out in paragraph 1 and for a judgment for \$6.00 under paragraph 2 and for all the costs of this action. No costs for all relief.
