The plaintiff, E.W.Reeves, states that on the 1st of January, 1920, he rented a house to the defendant at \$8.00 per months; that he took possession of it on said day and has occupied it continuously every since and that he has paid therefor nothing; that he owes on said rent the sum of \$160.00. He says in the Spring of 1921, he sold to the defendant an automobile tire for the sum of \$20.00 and that he has paid nothing thereon. He says this action is for money due upon contracts and that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's claim and the claims of the defendant creditors and that the collection of said demands will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found and that this claim is just and long past due.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$180.00, for all costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant. He prays for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled.
