ANSWER OF GARNISHEE,  
SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY  
IN KENTUCKY.

The Southern Railway Company in Kentucky, for answer as garnishee herein, states that, at the time the order of garnishment was served upon it herein, namely, on the 28th day of Apr 1900, it was indebted to the defendant James Boyd in the sum of Seventy-two dollars and 67 cents, and no more, and that, except as aforesaid, garnishee had no money, property, choses in action, or other evidences of debt in its possessions or under its control, belonging to the defendant, or in which the latter had any interest.
