### 143 HORSES BRING \$97,250

#### AT LEXINGTON SALE

With a bay colt by Bostonian, sire of Bottle Cap and Maedic, two of the year's outstanding two-year-olds, selling for \$3,600 out of the yearling consignment of Thomas Platt, owner of Brookdale Farm, a total of 143 horses were sold for \$97,150, an average of \$679, in the auctions at the Lexington Sales Paddock Wednesday morning and night.

Of the total number sold, 74 were yearlings and they passed under Auctioneer Ernest "Doc" Bond's hammer for \$47,850, an average of \$646.

The morning sale was made up of breeding stock and weanlings and 69 head sold for \$49,300, average \$714.

### CAPONE'S VILLA TO BE SOLD

The government gave notice this week it will sell Al Capone's big white villa on Palm Island, near Miami, Florida, at auction next month.

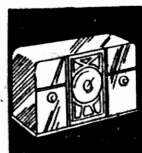
