The Plaintiff, the "ational Bank of Harrodsburg Ky,

states that it is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the
United States and doing business as a National Bank

It says that on Jan'y 23rd 1921 the said defendant James Bunton

by his promissory note which he executed and delivered to the plaintiff
agreed and promised six months thereafter to pay to the plaintiff

\$55. with interest thereon from date, no part of which has ever been
paid. Said note is filed herewith.

It says that the defendant is indebted to the plaintiff as

aforsaid : that said contract is evidenced by said note: that the

plaintiff ought to recover the amount aforsaid: that the defendant

has no property in this State subject to execution, and that he has

not enough property subject to execution in this State to satisfy

plaintiff's demand and that the collection of its demand will be

endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property

found.

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendant for the

said sum of \$55. with interest as aforsaid and for its cost and for

all proper relief, including an attachment against the defendant.
