Gomes Garnishee and states that on December 23, 1926, Will Lair, whose address is Burgin, Ky., delivered to it 325 pounds of tobacco of the 1926 crop, for which participation certificate 71062 was issued, on which the advance of \$23.20 was paid to Willie Lair; and on February 7, 1927, 1177 pounds were delivered, for which participation certificate 72033 was issued, on which the advance of \$78.68 was paid to H. T. Leon to apply on Landlord's lien.

Said tobacco is subject to a landlord's lien in favor of said H. T. Leon for a balance of \$21.32.

Garnishee has no record of any further deliveries of tobacco by defendant.

Garnishee will make further distribution payments on tobacco of the 1926 crop delivered to it by its member growers, but the dates and amounts of such payments are unknown to it. Garnishee is not informed that Will Lair, whose account is listed herein, and Will Lair, defendant herein, are one and the same person, but if such is not the case, it prays to be allowed to amend its answer accordingly.

WHEREFORE, Garnishee prays to be protected in its rights, for its costs herein expended, and for all proper relief.
