

ANSWER OF GARNISHEE, BURLEY TOBACCO
GROWERS COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION.

G. M. LEAR

DEFENDANT.

Gomes Garnishee and states that on January 11, 1924, Geo. Lear, whose address is Burgin, Ky., delivered to it 1630 pounds of tobacco of the 1923 crop, for which participation certificate 134888 was issued, on which the advance in the sum of \$108.63 was paid to said Geo. Lear.

Said certificate was assigned on February 4, 1924, to Citizens Bank and Trust Company of Burgin, Ky., for all proceeds, and the distribution accruing under same was paid to said bank on June 1, 1925, in the sum of \$48.49.

Garnishee further states that on December 14, 1926, Geo. Lear, whose address is Burgin, Ky., delivered to it 2783 pounds of tobacco of the 1926 crop, for which participation certificate 70909 was issued, on which the advance of \$237.08 was paid to G. M. Lear; and on January 31, 1927, 428 pounds were delivered, for which participation certificate 71830 was issued, on which the advance of \$31.00 ~~was~~ is being held by the Burley Association under the attachment herein, subject to the orders of the court.

Garnishee has no record of any further deliveries of tobacco made by defendant. Garnishee will make further distribution payments on tobacco of the 1923 and 1926 crops delivered to it by its member growers, but the dates and amounts of such payments are unknown to it.
