

at six per cent per annum until paid. Plaintiffs state that said is past due and that no part of the same has been paid and that the interest thereon is unpaid and past due.

Plaintiffs, state that this is an action upon a contract being a contract to pay money on a note; that said amount is just; that they believe they ought to recover the full amount of the note, to wit, \$115.37 with interest thereon from date until paid ; that defendant has no property in this state subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy and pay said indebtedness and the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found.

Wherefore plaintiffs pray for judgment against defendant for the sum of \$115.37; with interest thereon from August 1st., 1920 until paid; for costs of this action and for a general order of attachment of defendant's property including a summons against the garnishee, First National Bank, Mercer National Bank and the State Bank & Trust Company of Harrodsburg, Kentucky and for all other relief to which they may appear to be entitled.
