The plaintiff Burns & Roberts state that they are a firm doing a general Restaurant Business in Harrodsburg, Kentucky, composed of Rome Burns and Estel Roberts; they ^tsate that on the fifteenth day of April, 1922, at his special instance and request they loaned to the defendant Reed Hall, the sum of \$11,50, and which he promised and agreed to pay to plaintiff on April, 22nd, 1922; they say that their said claim is just, due and unpaid and that they have demanded payment of same but that defendant has failed and refused to pay said claim and that they believe they ought to recover said amount from the defendant with interest and costs of this action; they say that the defendant has no property in this State or not enough thereof subject to execution to satisfy plaintiffs demand and the demands of defendants creditors and that the collection of their claim will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment or a return of no property found; they say that they have been informed and believe that Walker Brothers of Harrodsburg, Ky, are indebted to the defendant and ask that they be summoned as garnishees herein.

Wherefore plaintiffs pray for a judgment against the defendant Reed Hall for the said sum of \$11,50 with 6% per annum interest from April, 15th, 1922 till paid, for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant, for their costs and all relief they may appear entitled to.
