The plaintiff, R.W.Boston, states that on the 16th day of August 1922, his car, a Ford Runabout, while being driven on the Bellows Mill Pike, a public thoroughfare in Mercer County, Ky., was run into, upon and over, by a car owned and operated by the defendants, or by them as agents for some one else whom the plaintiff does not know, and seriously injured and damaged by the negligent operation and management of said car while being driven by the defendants and that said damage to his machine as aforesaid was caused by and resulted from the careless and negligent operation and management of the ~~the~~ ^{car} driven by them as aforesaid in the sum of \$60.00; he says that said car was being driven at a rate of speed of more than ~~40~~ miles an hour and in violation of law and that said act constituted negligence per se and the resultant damage above mentioned. He prays for a judgment for \$60.00 and the cost of this action-
