

This cause coming on for trial and the defend-

ant, Henry B. Claunch, being present in person and by attorney, and the

plaintiff being present by attorney and both announcing ready for trial,

whereupon it was ordered by the Court that a jury come and pursuant to

a summons by the sheriff came the following jury, viz: T.R. Gritton, James

Logue, Kelly Perkins, Weldon Horn, Alex Hoberly, M.F. Cogar, W.M. Poulter,

Steve Chambers, Ralph Royalty, W.R. Anderson, Kyle Teater & Eugene Wells.

The jury being duly sworn by the Court and upon

hearing the evidence of witnesses, argument of counsel, and instructions

of the Court, retired to consider of their verdict and after due and

careful consideration and deliberation returned into Court the follow-

ing verdict: "We, the jury in the above case, find the defendant, Hen-

ry B. Claunch, guilty and fix his fine as follows: Eight Dollars per

month for the first two years and after two years Twelve Dollars and

Fifty Cents payable per month for next 14 years.

It is therefore ordered and adjudged that Henry B. Claunch is the

father of the illegitimate child born to Martha Patterson on the 21st

day of August 1925. It is further ordered and adjudged that the said

Henry B. Claunch pay to the said Martha Patterson for the use and ben-

efit of said infant child begotten and born to the said Henry B. Claunch

and Martha Patterson as aforesaid, the sum of Eight(\$8.00) Dollars per

month for first two years beginning on the 21st day of August 1925 and

ceeding 14 years from the expiration of said two years aforesaid.

Said payments to be made monthly beginning on the 21st day of

September 1925 and payable on the 21st day of each succeeding month for

a period of 16 years as aforesaid. The said Henry B. Claunch will, also,
