

MERCER COUNTY COURT

Sallie Rogers,

Upon Petition

Your petitioner would respectfully represent that she is the owner of a tract of land of about 45 acres lying upon the waters of Six river and adjoining the lands of Berry Sallee farm and lying upon the Baker Mill road and being the same land purchased by her at Commissioner's sale in the settlement of the estate of Alfred Rogers: that the said land was assessed in the Fall of 1922 under the name of "Alfred Rogers heirs" at \$3000. and that at the same time the Tax Commissioners assessed the said tract of land to "Alpha Rogers/heirs" at the same sum. That said assessment is of the same tract of land and is a double assessment of said land.

She says that she had no knowledge of said double assessment until this day, October 19th, 1923 when she attempted to pay her taxes on said land and discovered said double assessment.

Wherefore she prays that said assessment be stricken from the Commissioner's books as to that assessment made in the name of "Alpha Rogers heirs" there bein no such person and no such land, and that said assessment be made in her name as the true owner of the said land.
