The Plaintiff, First National Bank, states that the defendant Lester Wise, by his promissory note dated Feby 1st 1924 agreed and promised on Aug 14th 1924 to pay to ~~xxx~~ Martin E Walker \$171.14 with interest thereon from date ; that the said Wise executed and delivered said note to the said Walker and that the said Walker by his written indorsement thereon assigned and transferred to said note to plaintiff before maturity thereof. It says that no part of said note has ever been paid except the sum of \$75. paid July 1st 1925. Said note is filed herewith. It says that the said claim is just and that the plaintiff ought to recover of the defendant \$171.14 with interest thereon from Feby 1st 1924, subject to a credit of \$75.71 paid July 1st 1925 and the cost of this action. That the defendant has not sufficient property in this State subject to execution to satisfy the plaintiff's demand and that collection of its demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendant for the said sum and interest and for its cost, and for a general order of attachment including garnishee. It prays for all proper relief.
