

Third Harrodsburg Man Listed Dead In Pacific

HARRODSBURG, Ky., June 25 (Special)—News of the death of a third member of the former Harrodsburg National Guard, which went to the Philippines as Company 3, 192nd Tank Battalion, was received here Thursday. A wire from the War Department to Mr. and Mrs. J. M. Leonard informed them that the International Red Cross reported the death on June 11, 1943, of their grandson, Private First Class Fred Leonard Jr., of Harrodsburg.

He would have been 23 years old in August and was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Leonard Sr., formerly of Harrodsburg, but now of Dayton, Ohio.

Besides his parents, he is survived by a sister, Miss Betty Leonard, and two brothers, Jackie and Russell Leonard, all of Dayton.

The first notice of a death among the Harrodsburg men in the Philippines was that of Sergt. Wallace Denny, whose wife, Mrs. Alma Best Denny, was informed March 26, 1943, that her husband had been killed in action April 19, 1942. Last week Mr. and Mrs. O. W. Anness were notified of the death of their son, Sergt. Elzie Anness.
