

The affiant, states that he is a member of the partnership of Martin & Johnson; that said Martin & Johnson is the same firm who a short time ago filed a mechanic's and material men's lien in the Mercer County Court Clerk's Office against John Dunn for the sum of \$131.43; that in the affidavit then filed the car sought to be held in lien was there described as an "Overland car six cylinder five passenger" but that said car is more particularly described as "overland Car six cylinder seven passenger with Willy ~~xxxxxx~~ Engine"; said car is sometimes called Willys Six; that the first description given really sufficiently described the car, but in order that no one be misled they correct the description to this extent; they say that the original description was intended to describe the car now in use by said Dunn and the work labor and materials were furnished for and done on said Overland six cylinder seven passenger car with Willys Knight Engine and they assert and claim a lien on said car for the amounts as set forth in their original affidavit and claim.
