The plaintiffs, W. H. Royalty and W. P. Royalty, state that

they are partners, doing business under the firm name of Royalty Bros., and engaged in a general mercantile business at Salvisa, Mercer County, Kentucky, under and by the said partnership name.

They state that the defendant, Will Medley, is indebted to them in the sum of \$26.55, for goods, wares and merchandise, sold and delivered to the said defendant by these plaintiffs in the year 1920, at the said defendant's special instance and request. They file herewith, and hereby refer to and make a part of this statement, an itemized statement of account for said goods so sold and delivered, marked "A" for the purpose of identification; and state that the prices therefor, charged in said account, are reasonable, and that no part thereof has ever been paid; that the same has been past due since Jan. 1921

The plaintiffs state that the claim in this action for money against the said defendant, Will Medley, is for money due upon contract for goods, wares and merchandise sold and delivered to the said defendant, as aforesaid; that it is a just claim, and that they ought to recover of the said defendant the said sum of \$26.55, with interest thereon at 6% from January 1, 1921; that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy
