- Loss of hospital personnel on October 23, 1943, caused a reassignment on the Surgical Service. Captain Herold F. Bertram, was relieved of duty with the Surgical Service on that date.
- 2. A survery of the breast tumor cases in camp with the surgical removal of one selected tumor for gross pathological study was done by the surgical viewed three months ago are now again being investigated with regard to the spontaneous disappearence of these tumors or their persistence. At here inserted, some of those cases already seen 785 have shown spontaneous disappearence with no residual pathology. It is hoped that this work will be completed in the ensueing month.
- 3. The treatment of tricothyton infections with the electrolytic copper sulfate bath has given us an increased percentage of cures this month. Out of fifty cases which were given this treatment fifteen responded with complete cures from eight to twelve treatments. This gives a curative percentage thirty percent which is six and one third than the original stated percentages of cures.
- 4. Sixty-four (64) procedures were performed in the major operating room this month. The following cases composed this total:
