Plaintiff, First National Bank, of Harrodsburg, Kentucky states that it is now, and has been for many years a banking institution, organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of Kentucky and the United States, and at the present time has its principal place of business in the city of Harrodsburg, Kentucky; it states that defendants, John Deshazer and Sallie Deshazer by a writing dated April 13, 1923, which they executed and delivered to this plaintiff, a copy of which is filed herewith as part hereof, and marked exhibit "A", promised to pay to plaintiff the sum of \$120.14, six months after date, with interest from date until paid.

Plaintiff states that said note is past due, and is unpaid, that same is not subject to any credit, and that the full amount of said note together with interest thereon from date of note remains unpaid.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays judgment against defendants for the sum of \$120.14, with interest thereon from April 13, 1923; and for cost of this action, and for all other relief to which it may appear to be entitled.
