Word that her son-in-law, Lieut. Marion L. Danan, is being held as prisoner of war by the Japanese in the Philippines was received yesterday by Mrs. Evert Thomas, 1621 Edgeland, from the War Department. Her husband, Maj. Evert Thomas, previously had been reported a prisoner.

Mrs. Thomas and her daughter, Mrs Elizabeth Danan, who lives with her mother and is employed at Fort Knox, last heard from their husbands in February, 1942. Mrs. Thomas returned to Louisville six months before the war broke out.

Her son, Sergt. George N. Thomas, 19, joined the Army at Fort McKinley, Philippines, in order to stay with his father. She now has hopes that her son, ler, all of Harrodsburg.
