Can We Afford Not  
To Have Recreation?

Voicing a strong plea that the integrity of local recreation bodies be maintained, and cautioning local leaders against leaning too heavily upon national funds and direction, Mrs. Eugene Meyer, Chairman, Westchester County (N. Y.) Recreation Commission, told the delegates at the National Recreation Congress, in Chicago last month, that recreation offered a valuable means of helping to save democracy in America. Mrs. Meyer said:

"Any community which loves the free institutions of this country and wishes to preserve them should be not only willing but anxious to support a recreation program in addition to its regular provisions for public schools.

"So definitely and clearly is this true that the property owner and taxpayer who is anxious to stave off fascism or communism must no longer ask himself, 'Can we afford recreation?' If he has any insight whatsoever, any interest in protecting and furthering our democratic form of government, he must say to himself, 'Can we afford not to have recreation?' In other words,

## let's stop our apologetic, defensive attitude toward our various local budget makers and demand that recreation be given the importance in our educational scheme to which it has proved itself to be entitled.


