

the defendant Mrs S M Gibson on Oct 26th 1922 executed and delivered to the plaintiff a mortgage on her one undivided half interest in about four acres of tobacco raised upon her place near Salvisa, Mercer County Kentucky, by the defendant John Bunton; that the said Bunton and said Gibson are living together and that they are about to remove the said tobacco from the said farm of the said Gibson greatly to its injury: that the same has not been stripped or prepared for market and that the said Bunton is under legal obligation to the said Gibson to strip the same and place it upon the market but that he has neglected, failed and refused to do so and that the said Gibson is about to sell, convey and otherwise dispose of said tobacco with the fraudulent intent to cheat, hinder and delay the plaintiff; that she has no property in this State subject to execution except the interest in said tobacco so mortgaged to the ~~defax~~ plaintiff and that the demand of plaintiff will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.

*That said claims are just and that the plaintiff
right to receive the amount of said debt is paid payable.*

it says that by reason of the perishable nature of said tobacco and by reason of the cost of keeping the same, a sale of the same should be made immediately

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendant Gibson for the said sum of \$111.60 with interest from Nov 1st 1920 and for ~~\$14xx~~ \$15. with interest from July 1st 1922 and the cost of this action. It prays for a general order of attachment and for an order of sale of the said tobacco ~~xx~~ It prays for all general and equitable relief.
