The plaintiff A.B.Teater says that the defendant L.E.Graves is indebted to him in the sum of \$56,07, with 6% per annum interest thereon from the 10th, day of December, 1922, evidenced by a certain promissory note which the defendant executed and delivered to the plaintiff and by the terms of which he promised and agreed to pay plaintiff the above named amount in sixty days from date of said note and he files said note herewith as a part hereof.

Plaintiff says that said note is just due and unpaid and that demand of payment has been made of the defendant.

Wherefore plaintiff prays judgment against the defendant L.E.Graves for said sum of \$56,07 with 6% per annum interest thereon from the 10th, day of December, 1921 till paid, for his costs and whatever relief he may appear entitled to.
