BAIL BOND

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant George Temple being in custody
of the Constable of Mercer County, charged with the offense

of uttering a worthless check and
being admitted to bail in the sum of Two hundred Dollars:

THEREFORE, we George Temple Principal

tion thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that
we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of \$200.00
