

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff or any Constable of Mercer County:

Whereas Albert Skinner hath made complaint to me as Judge of the Mercer County Court, that Thomas Webb

did on the day of January 1916, forcibly

enter into take possession of and detain from said Albert Skinner a house and lot in Mercer County, Ky on the farm of Albert Skinner being bounded on the north by C.N. Wilder and on the East south and west by Albert Skinners land

which was in the peaceable possession of said Albert Skinner

You are therefore commanded to summon the said Webb

to appear at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky., to answer on the day of February 1916, 191, the charge

of forcible entry and detainer aforesaid, and give to the said Webb at least three days' notice of the time and place of the trial, and have then and there this writ.
