

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff or any Constable of Mercer County:

Whereas W. A. McFartridge hath made complaint to me as Judge of the Mercer County Court, that Arch Dyehouse

did on the 1st day of January 1916, forcibly detain from him the up-stairs portion of the Bell store room on west side of Main Street, in Harrodsburg, Ky known as the bakery building the lower story of which is occupied by the Duwell Barber shop

which was in the peaceable possession of said McFartridge

You are therefore commanded to summon the said Dyehouse

to appear at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky., to answer on the 10th day of January 1916, the charge

of forcible detainer aforesaid, and give to the said Arch Dyehouse at least three days' notice of the time and place of the trial, and have then and there this writ.
