

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff or any Constable of Mercer County:

Whereas S.B. Smith, hath made

complaint to me as Judge of the Mercer County Court, that

Charley Browning

did on the 25 day of June 1915, forcibly

detain from him a house, garden and lot in Mercer County on the farm of
S.B. Smith in which said Browning now lives

which was in the peaceful possession of said Browning now holds against him as
tenant

You are therefore commanded to summon the said Browning

to appear at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky., to answer on the
day of June 28, 1915, the charge

of forcible detainer aforesaid, and give to the said
Browning at least three days' notice of the time and place of the trial, and have then and there this writ.
