

The Sheriff of Mercer County having required a bond of indemnity before levying an execution issued on the 13th day of June 1914 from the Mercer Quarterly Court in favor of Lee Smock<sup>Co</sup> and against W. C. Forsythe for the sum of \$22<sup>00</sup> and \$37<sup>50</sup> costs upon a bunch of sheep consisting of about 40 old ~~sheep~~ <sup>also a crop of wheat</sup> sheep and about 40 lambs with them, said property now in possession of said W. C. Forsythe on farm rented by him in Mercer County; we undertake to indemnify the said Sheriff against the damages which he may sustain in consequence of the seizure or sale of the aforesaid property; also to pay to any claimant thereof the damages which he may sustain in consequence of such seizure or sale, and to warrant to any purchaser of said property such estate or interest therein as may be sold.
