To the sheriff of Mercer County;-

Whereas, Jouett Allin, Jas. C. Allin, Bush W. Allin, Jennie Osborn, Ben C. Allin, Jno. W. Allin Margaret Karhl, Susan Perkins Edw. W. Allin, Thos. Allie and Annie Keith Allin have made complaint to me that Manlius Steel did on the day of July 1915 forcibly detain from them a house and lot on the North side of Moreland Avenue, in Harrodsburg, Ky bounded on the north by J. H. Vandivider, on the East by W. Y. Graves, on the South by Moreland Avenue and on the West by D. N. Rue, which said property was in the possession of Manlius Steel as their tenant but which he the said Steel now holds against them;-

You are therefore commanded to notify the said Manlius Steel to appear before me at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky at 10 a.m. on Wednesday August 4th, 1915 at which time and place inquiry will be made and a trial had as to said forcible detainer, and you will have then and there this writ.
