

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff or any Constable of Mercer County:

Whereas Abe Lyons bath made complaint to me as Judge of the Mercer County Court, that

Muscoo Vanarsdall did on the 25th day of January, 1915, forcibly

detain from him, a house and lot situated in Harrodsburg, Kentucky,

on Cogar Avenue, which was in the peaceable possession of said Vanarsdall now holds as tenant against him.

You are therefore commanded to summon the said Muscoo Vanarsdall

to appear at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky., to answer on the 28th day of January, 1915, the charge at 10 o'clock a.m.

of forcible detainer aforesaid, and give to the said Muscoo Vanarsdall at least three days' notice of the time and place of the trial, and have then and there this writ.
