

To The Sheriff of Mercer County.

D. L. Moore, having by attorney made complaint to me that Prewitt Bros, a firm composed of W. O. Prewitt and E. A. Prewitt, did on the day of December 1914 forcibly detain from him a double store house and lot on the

West side of Main Street in Harrodsburg, Ky, bounded on the north by the property of W. C. Bell, on the East by Main Street, on the South by the property of W. C. Bell and on the West by the property of A. D. Price estate, which property was in the peaceable possession of said Prewitt Bros tenants of the said D. L. Moore, but which they now hold against him;

You are therefore commanded to summon them to appear before me at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky on Thursday December 24th, 1914 at 10 a.m. at which time a trial will be had as to said forcible detainer and you will give them at least three days notice of the hearing of this writ and have then and there this writ.
