The plaintiff, W. L. Graham, states that on the 22nd day of December, 1919, the defendants, Ezra Curtsinger and Rastus Dennis, by their certain joint promissory note of said date, by them executed and delivered to H. H. Graham, agreed and promised to pay to the said H. H. Graham, Twelve Months thereafter, the sum of Sixty (\$60.00), with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum from the date of the said note, as aforesaid, until the same should be paid.

That thereafter the said H. H. Graham, by his written endorsement thereon, assigned and transferred the said note to the plaintiff, together with all the rights and benefits thereof, and the plaintiff is now the owner and holder of the said note. The said note is hereto attached and is filed herewith, and is hereby referred to and made a part hereof for any and all purposes whatsoever, and is marked "Exhibit A," for the purpose of identification. He states that the said note is past due, and that no part thereof has ever been paid.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff prays judgment against the said defendants for his said debt, the said sum of Sixty Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum from December 22, 1919, for his costs and for all proper relief.
