Plaintiff, Curtis Allin, states that defendant, Red Star Transportation Company on the 666 day of May 1924 entered into a contract in this county with this plaintiff under the terms of which contract plaintiff promised and agreed to circulate a petition in the county of Mercer and Boyle and to obtain thereupon names of citizens who were interested in having the defendant continue to engage in the business of transporting passengers and in the general bus line business, which petition defendant defendant desired to use in connection with obtaining a license to engage in the general bus line business; that in consequence of said contract this plaintiff did present said petition to the citizens of Mercer and Boyle counties and did obtain thereupon names of many citizens of the said counties of Mercer and Boyle and in all respects carried out his contract with defendant.

Plaintiff states that in consideration of his circulating said petition and obtaining the names of citizens thereon that defendant promised and agreed to pay plaintiff the reasonable value of said work immediately upon completion of same; that said work has been completed and that the reasonable value of said work is \$75.00 which amount defendant has failed and refused to pay
