

The affiant, J. T. Ingram states that he is engaged in the general garage business at Harrodsburg, KY under the name and style of Ingram's Garage; that Etta B. McAtee and J. G. McAtee are ~~the~~ the owners of a Cadillac Touring~~xx~~ Sedan Type 59 Suburban, Motor #59-0-624; jointly that J. G. McAtee at all the times complained of in this affidavit was the agent and representative of Etta B. McAtee in the management control and operation of said automobile; that during the months of July, August, Octo, Nov, Dec 1923 ~~and~~ at the special instance and request of J. G. McAtee owner and agent of the other owner of said automobile, this affiant, furnished for the use of said automobile, labor, parts, material, supplies, gas and oils as are fully set out in an itemized account thereof annexed hereto and made a part hereof marked #1 for identity, to the amount of \$261.20, which amounts the said J. G. McAtee owner and agent of the other owner agreed and promised to pay ~~them~~ to this affiant, but that although said sums are past due no part thereof has ever been paid except the sum of \$150 paid Nov. 3 1923; that said account shows all the items charged thereon with the amounts charged for same, and shows all credits to which they~~re~~ are entitled to and there is no offset or discount to or against the same; that all of said articles so furnished were actually used in on and in connection with said automobile and accepted by the owners thereof and added to the value thereof. He asserts a lien on said car for \$111.20 with interest and costs of filing this lien.
