The Plaintiff states that he is engaged in business in

Harrodsburg, Ky as Ingram's Garage and in the general garage business

in which he receives and stores automobiles and repairs the same turning

parts, material labor and supplies for the same; that the defendants are the

joint owners of a Sedan Type 59 Cadillac Car Motor 59-Q-624; that at their

special instance and request during the months of July, August, Octo Nov

and Dec 1923, and at the dates more fully set out in the itemized account

filed herewith as a part hereof, he furnished sold and delivered to them

the labor, parts, repairs and supplies which were used on for and in connec-

tion with said automobile as are fully itemized in the account filed here-

with, and at the agreed prices therein set out so that on Dec 1, 1923 there

was due to him therefor the sum of \$111.20; that thereafter on Jan 29,

1924 he filed in the office of the Clerk Mercer County Court his affidavit

showing the amount of articles and property so furnished the amounts charged

and agreed to be paid for same with all credits thereon to which the debts

were entitled and thereby asserted a lien on said car; that he files herewith

as a part hereof said original paper and lien the expense of filing which was
