

4 You will then strike a balance between the sums found for the Plaintiff and for the defendant and return your verdict in favor of the one to whom the balance if any is due.

5 However, if you believe that about January 1927 the parties had a settlement by which all the claims in evidence were settled except the DeBaun grocery bill and leaving the defendant owing that amount you will find for the Plaintiff \$142.00 ~~with interest as~~
~~from the day of 1927 and find nothing~~
~~for defendant.~~
