

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

R. L. Carrier,

has committed the offense of

flourishing or using in a threatening or boisterous manner, a deadly weapon

in the County of Mercer, the 22 day of JULY 1930.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said R. L. Carrier,

and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
